Hydroweld's unique and unrivalled internationally recognised wet welder training courses in Thailand are hosted at Mermaid Maritime Ltd state of the art training facility at Pinthong near Laem Chabang, Thailand.

The courses, which are modular, are run over 10 days* and are intended to take students up to a standard set by Hydroweld and as a minimum, to a skill level to pass a Welder Performance Qualification (WPQ) to the latest version of the AWS D3.6M Specification for Underwater Welding. The WPQ test is completed on the final day and is witnessed by Lloyds Register** (LR) who will issue successful students with the WPQ certification. LR is an internationally recognised classification society and certification issued by them is generally accepted by other classification societies throughout the world.

The courses are aimed at professional divers who hold an appropriate 'commercial diver qualification' and who wish to pursue a career in wet welding and/or who wish to improve on their current wet welding capabilities and gain an internationally recognised wet welding qualification. Whilst no previous welding experience is required it is an advantage and preferred. The courses are predominantly practical and provide the student with a real opportunity to understand and develop skills to a repeatable high standard in the art of wet welding. The modular programme allows students to develop their skills over a period of time, building on the skills gained from a previous module to suit their finances and schedule and gives dedicated students who wish to specialise in wet welding the opportunity to progress on to more demanding joint geometry's and positions.

The price of the course includes all the materials, consumables, testing and Lloyds witnessing but accommodation, travelling expenses, subsistence or personal expenses are not. A light lunch (included in the price) is provided at the facility, as is tea and coffee etc. All diving, welding and safety equipment is provided but you will need to bring along you own wet suits and personal work gear i.e. overalls and boots.

Accommodation is extremely good value for money in Thailand and can be arranged as detailed on the enrolment form. A mini bus or similar is available free of charge to transfer between the hotel and the training centre or students can make their own way.

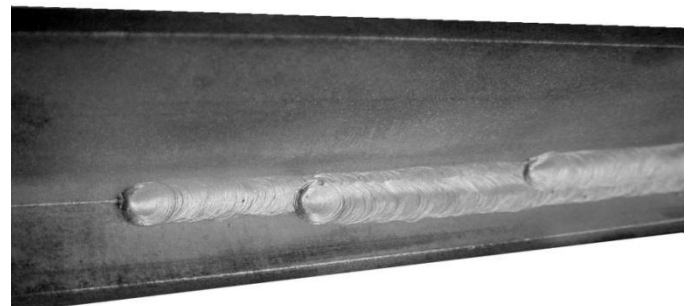
